
The stunning authentic nature of Inari makes it the most attractive tourist destinations of Lapland. Fall in love with North Lapland make some great memories under the midnight sun!

INARI PRE-TOUR PROGRAM

Day 1 | Friday 24.7.2020 | Rovaniemi - Kittilä - Inari (L/D)

Meet your local tour leader and driver in Rovaniemi in the morning, and hop on the bus towards a two day pre-tour to Inari. On our way, we will stop at Särestöniemi including a guided tour of the gallery and studio which showcases works of art by Reidar Särestöniemi. Lunch will be served in Kittilä before transfering to Inari. After you check in, you'll have a nice local dinner at the hotel's restaurant. The main course will be local fish, but if you have special dietary needs, the chef will prepare something else for you.

Day 2 | Saturday 25.7.2020 | Inari (B/L/D)

Today, you will have the perfect opportunity to see the beautiful nature of Lapland as well as get acquainted with the Sámi native region. The day starts with a ~2,5h cruise on thse Lake Inari, which gives you the perfect way to experience one of the biggest arctic wilderness lakes in Northern Lapland and visit the mysterious Ukonsaari island. The catamaran has 120 seats, and you can buy beverages and small snacks on board.

After lunch in Inari, we will be visiting Sajos, a Sàmi cultural and administrative centre. We will also visit the Sàmi Siida Museum and Northern Lapland Nature Centre's exhibitions. You'll get the chance to learn about ancient and vibrant Sàmi culture, and about arctic nature.

The dinner will be accompanied with a preformance by Sàmi artist. Main course of the evening will be reindeer, but if you have special dietary needs, the chef will prepare something else for you.

Day 3 | Sunday 26.7.2020 | Inari - Kakslauttanen - Rovaniemi (B/L)

After check out, we will drive approximately 1 hour to visit Kakslauttanen. Kakslauttanen is known for it's glass igloos but also for it's local art. Lunch will be served in one of Kakslauttanen's beautiful restaurant where you can admire beautiful works of art while enjoying your meal.



HOTEL

During this pre-tour, you will be staying in the center of Inari. This hotel is on the shore of Lake Inari. The hotel has a sauna on additional cost, as well as a gourmet Lappish restaurant with lake views.

Siida Sámi Museum and the Northern Lapland Nature Centre are located next to the hotel.


